A summary of the results from the Student Satisfaction Survey is provided below:


Most students agree that teachers complete the curriculum on time, arrive at class well-prepared, and have outstanding communication skills. The way the teacher taught the material, in the opinion of the pupils, was very good. The concepts being taught are supplemented as necessary with additional inputs, examples, and illustrations. The majority of students feel that the college actively involves them in the teaching and learning process. The majority of students concur that the teaching-learning modules are outstanding and that the majority of teachers use ICT technology to enhance teaching-learning experience.

Majority of the students attended the survey agree that think there is a good feedback system in place where teachers often discuss students' performance with them and follow up on assigned work, and that the evaluation procedure for in-class tests and assignments is always fair.






How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? Figure 2




Count of How well did the teachers prepare for the classes

How well were the teachers able to communicate? Figure 3




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as Figure 4






Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers Figure 5




Count of Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers


Count of Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?






Count of The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

Count of Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes
















Count of The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and probl...


